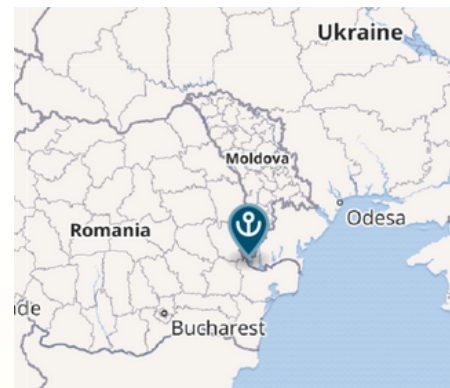


## DELIVERING U.S. SUPPORT TO THE PEOPLE OF UKRAINE

## OUR PRESENCE IN UKRAINE

- Opened first office in the country in 2017.
- Delivered and paid for humanitarian aid, Starlinks, and critical support to the country in the first week of the invasion.
- Continue to provide critical materials to Ukrainian government entities and businesses at scale.
- Provider of choice for numerous U.S. companies moving materials to Ukraine.
- Doubled our headcount in country since the 2022 invasion, now 70+ FTEs and growing.
- Opened two additional offices weeks after the invasion, adding Kyiv and Odessa to our longstanding presence in Ivano Frankivsk.
- Full spectrum logistics, supply chain, projects, and technology solutions.
- Provide mobile project teams that operate across the country to support our clients onsite.
- Coordinate closely with Ukrainian government, military, and civil society.



## Q4 2023 ACTIVITIES

- Delivered over 20,000 metric tons/48 million pounds of critical infrastructure material to Ukraine.
- Managed four ocean vessels of cargo to Constanta- with dedicated LP teams onsite at critical transit and unloading points.
- Managed over 1,000 truckloads from Ukrainian ports to destinations across the country.
- Secured and managed 18 barge transits from Constanta to Port Reni.
- Sorted and dispatched for delivery thousands of large-scale components for gas drilling platforms at Port of Reni over a multi week period despite ongoing drone and missile attacks by Russian forces on port facilities.
